WAYNE COUNTY COMMUNITY FOUNDATION MATCHING GIFT GRANT

The 200 wing of the Apostolic Christian Home is in need of major renovation of its hallway and family lounge area. Our goal is to raise \$31,000 to cover the estimated cost of material and hired labor for the Project. We are also hopeful of receiving around \$7,000 of volunteer labor.

The Wayne County Community Foundation (WCCF) has awarded Apostolic Christian Home a matching grant of \$6,000 to support the Project. In order to receive the \$6,000 grant money, the Home was required to raise \$12,000 from donors.

In order to attain the \$31,000 Project Goal, additional donations of \$11,300 are needed. We recommend that gifts be made in one of the following ways:

- Make a cash donation to the Business Office of the Home by placing the money in an envelope with a note stating "200 Wing Project" donation.


